ROOM IN OUR HOUSE is a unique international collaboration, a thought-provoking dance theater performance and a close encounter co-created by Nicole Beutler Projects and Haudenosaunee artists.

Four hundred years ago, the colonisation of the original inhabitants of Turtle Island began when the Dutch sailed up the Hudson River. The indigenous Haudenosaunee made 'room in their house' for the uninvited guests. They created the Two Row Wampum, a beaded belt as contract for eternal peace and friendship. As the only treaty that has never been broken, it is a seed for hope and forms the starting point for this urgent work. Co-directed by Nicole Beutler and Michelle Schenandoah, with the powerful words of Oneida writer Ty Defoe and the filmic soundtrack of composer Gary Shepherd (GB/NL), the male dancers

Rob Polmann and Montana Summers re-enact this gesture of hospitality, confronting the challenges of their different heritage, building pathways towards an equal and shared future.

The piece reflects on one of the most urgent questions of our time: How to live together in peace?

Every performance is followed by an in-depth conversation with the audience on the topics of the work.

Nicole Beutler is an award-winning dance theatre artist based in the Netherlands. She is internationally known for her unique approach on the intersection of performance, dance, fine art and music theatre. She creates theatre as a "Gesamtkunstwerk" focusing on the questions of the climate and our future. Already for 30 years her artistic voice has impacted the international dance scene. Since 2009 Nicole Beutler Projects produces her works, structurally supported by the Dutch government.
